Top Events at Westmill Farm - Activities Portfolio

The following section gives a brief taster of some of the more popular activities that we run for our corporate clients at Westmill Farm. Although the activities are listed within zones all activities across all zones are available for multi-activity days.

- the climbing zone -

Huge Aerial Adventure course

the largest and most impressive high ropes course in the region, with over 50 individual elements, on 6 separate journeys of varying height and difficulty, including 4 exit zip lines. Which element will challenge you?

The BIG ZIP

possibly the most fun you will have this year! if you can conquer the 10 metre climb up the pole to the wobbly launch platform. Then all you have to do is hang on for 120m... A scream is compulsory.

Platform Abseil

learn how to safely lower yourself to the ground from one of our ropes course platforms. A test of your nerve and head for heights.

Climbing Wall

a formidable structure standing at over 8m high this is quite a demanding activity for almost anyone. Race your colleagues to the top or become one of a select few to conquer the pink climb!



- the target zone -

Target archery

all the Robin Hood and Maid Marion's amongst you will be battling to compete in this tournament which suits all abilities. Our favourite.

Laser Clay shooting

the skill and competitiveness of shooting at clay pigeons but with no recoil. The perfect activity for a team building competition or just plain old entertainment.

Axe Throwing

release that pent up energy with a round or two of axe throwing. Use the monstrous yet perfectly balanced double headed axe or the lighter tomahawks to get a perfect 'stick' in our tree trunk 'rounds'.

Air Gun shooting

use our full power rifles to shoot at a variety of targets such as the traditional zoned card as well as steel knock-down and spinner targets. Who will be the sharpest shooter in the West(mill).



- the motor zone -

Argos

no not the shop - these are amphibious 6 wheel drive off-roaders with a handlebar control. These vehicles demand a high level of co-ordination and control when driving on unforgiving terrain.



Pilots

single seater, 400cc, fast dune buggies. Race the clock or refine your driving skills with these exciting, easy to drive, rapid cornering off-road rockets.



Quad Bikes

everyone's favourite off-roader. The marshalls can score riders on their performance along a quad trail or have their skills tested on a quad obstacle course.



Rage Buggies

a single seater, 614cc racing buggy. Speed is what these machines are about. Try some high speed circuit navigation.



Segways

much more relaxing - follow off-road adventure trails, have a treasure hunt, 5-a-side polo or whatever game you can invent on these self balancing 2 wheeled little marvels.

Powerturns

Dual seated, 195cc twin engined vehicles which can spin 360° on their own axis and are steered by varying the throttle or brake on either of the engines. A totally different driving discipline, they can power slide around corners, perform doughnuts and wheelies. Tackle a demanding off road course in them, or take part in a spot of Powerturn Snooker; attempting to hit large coloured balls in a certain order and in the quickest time.



Crazy Tractor

single seater motorised lawn mowers - sounds OK so far - except the steering is reversed! Teams try and navigate a course - a very comical scene.

- the team challenge zone -

Tug-o-War

test your team's strength and determination. Fun to watch and to compete.



- the team challenge zone (continued) -

Raft building

everyone gets hands on. Has your team the skills to build a raft from the components provided? Start by designing your raft then you build it and finally cross the water on it - hope you don't mind getting wet...



Treasure Hunt

race against the other teams to follow the clues and complete the hunt. A pleasant treat awaits the winners.

Blindfold Challenge

two members of your team will erect a tent whilst blindfolded with only your instructions to guide them. A real test of your team's communication skills - and no peeping.



Ski race

four people facing in different directions on two giant skis use all of their combined coordination, teamwork and balance to manoeuvre themselves through the slalom course. Frustrating but fun.



Duck herding

unusual but exactly what it says. It's a great team building event where you have a chance to work your own sheepdog.

- the high energy zone -

Bouncy Boxing

strap on the biggest boxing gloves you've ever seen, climb into the inflatable ring and bounce around trying to land the knockout punch on your sparring partner.



Surf Challenge

with your own surfboard and goggles in place try belly surfing on an inflatable run. Who will slide the furthest?

Bungee Run

after being harnessed to a bungee cord you must use all your body strength to sprint along the alley and place your beanbag as far away from the start as possible.



- the high energy zone (continued) -

Human Table Football

two teams are strapped to poles to compete against each other in this life size version of a very traditional game.



Pedestal Joust

use your jousting skills to knock your opponent off the pedestal and onto the inflatable flooring. Enjoy this Gladiator style battle.



Penalty Shoot Out

kick Velcro covered footballs at the targets. Can you beat the goalie and make them stick?

- the skills zone -

Golf

the beautiful landscape and peaceful setting of our splendid 9 hole par 3 course make playing a round a real pleasure. Perfect for experienced players or new starters. The nine holes range between a 77 & 132 yards. Some relaxing exercise for your group.



Fishing

an introduction to fly-fishing on one of our still water lakes. We supply all the gear and we provide instruction. A pleasant way to make the most of our beautiful setting by the lakes.

Sheep Shearing

watch the experts at work, they will educate and entertain you with their skills and knowledge of the countryside. You may even like to try a little shearing for yourself.



Microlight flights

reach for the sky with an instructor in a microlight aircraft. During this flight you will actually fly the aircraft yourself.

Birds of prey

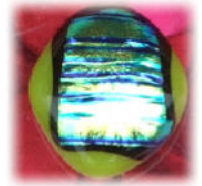
a breathtaking display of flying skills from a variety of birds of prey. We can include hands on experience in the art of falconry as well.



- the creative zone -

Fused Glass & Mosaics

Using fused glass create coasters, sun catchers, pendants, cufflinks, earrings and rings by cutting coloured glass, foils and metals to form creative designs or create a mosaic framed mirror using ceramic tiles.



Jewellery Making

Create a chunky funky bracelet using colourful non-precious metal by threading, twisting and wrapping or design and build a necklace using wire and chain in conjunction with beads and other materials to create your own charms.



Art & Pottery

Take a creative approach to drawing the human figure using inks, use a watercolour palette to create a dynamic picture, try a still life study in oils or hand build your own item of pottery with decoration to finish.

Meeting rooms

There are 2 meeting rooms both of which are fully serviced with their own bar, toilet facilities, white walls for projectors, wifi, power outlets, extension leads, smoker's courtyard, etc. Whiteboard, flipchart and LCD projector are available on request as are additional tables for break off/group work.

The *Old Tack room* is ideal for groups of up to 50 and the *Arched Barn* has a maximum capacity of 250 (both capacities are dependent on the required room layout).

Delegate Day packages

We offer 3 delegate day rated packages to suit both the style of your gathering as well as your budget. The choice of morning or afternoon for meetings and activities is totally your decision.

Gold Package includes: tea, coffee & bacon rolls served on arrival, tea, coffee & biscuits served mid morning, 'Two course' fork buffet lunch with orange juice, tea coffee & homemade cakes served mid afternoon.
